Frankly Speaking...

As we all bundle up against the cold of the season, we can take hope in warmer weather to come – because Easter is not that far away! The liturgical season of Lent is right around the corner. It begins with our **Ash Wednesday Service on February 18, 6p.m. in the Church Chapel.** (Across the hall from the Church Office for those of you who don't know.) Lent, of course, is the 40-day Christian season of prayer, fasting, and repentance leading up to Easter. Symbolizing Jesus's 40 days in the desert; it traditionally involves spiritual practices of self-denial, almsgiving, and reflection to prepare for celebrating Christ's resurrection. People often give up “luxuries” or “bad habits” as a form of devotion and focus on prayer and generosity to deepen their faith.

Key aspects of Lent:


- **Duration:** 40 days (not counting Sundays, which are seen as mini-celebrations of the Resurrection).
- **Starts:** Ash Wednesday, (this year – February 18) marked by receiving ashes in the shape of a cross on the forehead.
- **Ends:** The evening of Holy Thursday, before Easter. (NOTE: We will have an Upper Room Service on Wednesday, April 1, 6 p.m. as part of the Lenten Wednesday night dinners and services sponsored by the Elders. This year we will celebrate a Seder Meal as part of the service. (Details to come...))
- **Practices:** Prayer, fasting (abstaining from certain foods or habits), and almsgiving (giving to the poor) are central.
- **Purpose:** To prepare for Easter by focusing on spiritual renewal, repentance, and following Christ's example.
- **Biblical basis:** Mirrors Jesus's 40 days of temptation and prayer in the wilderness.

Common observances:

- Giving up something pleasurable (e.g., alcohol, social media, sweets).
- Abstaining from meat on Fridays.
- Increasing prayer, reading scripture, and performing acts of charity or service.





It's really cold. Snuggle up to the fire or heater and enjoy a good read!



Babylon Rising by Tim LaHaye. This is the first book of a new series. These books are fast paced thrillers based on prophesies not covered in his Left Behind series that are relevant to events today. This book introduces a new hero – Michael Murphy, who is a scholar of Biblical prophesy. He is a field archeologist who defies danger to fearlessly hunt down and authenticate ancient artifacts from Biblical times. His latest discovery is his most amazing – but it will sent him hurtling from a life of excavations and revelations to a confrontation with the forces of the greatest evil. The latest ancient secret uncovered by Michael Murphy accelerates the countdown to the endtime for all mankind.

The secret of Ararat also by Tim LaHaye is Book 2 of the series begun with Babylon Rising. Michael Murphy has another whirlwind adventure in pursuit of Biblical artifacts relating to Noah's Ark. His death defying quest to ascend Mount Ararat leads him to discover revelations of Biblical prophesies and be drawn into a terrifying evil about to be unleashed on all of mankind.

Mind Siege is yet another book by Dr. Tim LaHaye. This book deals with the battle for truth in the new millennium. He sounds the trumpets of alarm calling on us to wake up and defend out right to believe and behave as Christians among secular humanists. He urges Christians to understand the tenets of secular humanism – atheism, evolution, amorality, human autonomy and globalism. He urges God's servants to rise up and oppose Satan's strategies to take over our land.
